# VISITOR PARKING & VALIDATION INSTRUCTIONS



**VISITOR PARKING**  
Please park on the first two floors of the parking garage located in the northwest corner of Grace Court.

## 1. Park & Scan

- > Park in visitor parking — levels 1 and 2 of garage
- > Scan the QR code on any Scan-to-Pay sign

## 2. Enter Details

- > Choose parking duration (including buffer time)
- > Complete form — add license plate number, mobile phone number, email and payment information

## 3. Confirm Payment

- > Screen displays confirmation
- > Fee is charged immediately based on selected time at a rate of \$3/hour, \$15/day max

## 4. Upon Arrival, Validate at the Front Desk

- > Open your reservation screen and scroll to “Apply Validation,” tap to open phone camera
- > Scan validation QR code at the Front Desk
- > “Validation Applied” will appear in green at the top of the screen
